- The Charley Graves team has submitted 9347 BBS cards of which 2837 documented SWA was exercised!! The Charley Graves rig team has submitted 24 SWA drills since Jan (2008). These drills are well received by the Charley Graves team and help promote a team approach to safety.... Everyone working on this rig is committed to sending everyone home safely.

Miclyn Express Offshore Pte. Ltd. (MEO)

■ The MEO management team initiated a program called “SSS” – See it, Stop it, Save it. As a result there were 28 SWA exercised by MEO Captains.

Mainly related to:

- -STOP transferring passenger during bad weather or over vessel capacity
- -STOP loading cargo if crane operation is not using radio, or do not follow crane signal etc.

All of the 28 Stop Work actions submitted were communicated, documented, and agreed on by all concerned parties. Clearly illustrating that Stop Work is a partnership and that it's by working together that IFO is achievable.

This was immediately recognized and identified as a high risk and unplanned activity which prompted Torsten and Terry to Stop Work... A good safety culture encourages everyone to become a safety leader and be accountable for their actions regarding safety...

Tanker Pacific (Thailand) Co., Ltd.

- The Tanker Pacific crew had some concerns with the Mercury (Hg) levels in the produced water discharge. The crew took action to STOP Work and shut down our overboarding of produced water.

Their actions led to a series of process improvement associated with our handling of produced water.



Stop Work - Tenet #8

Thai Nippon Steel (TNS), Sunan Sripapan, Somkid Tansang

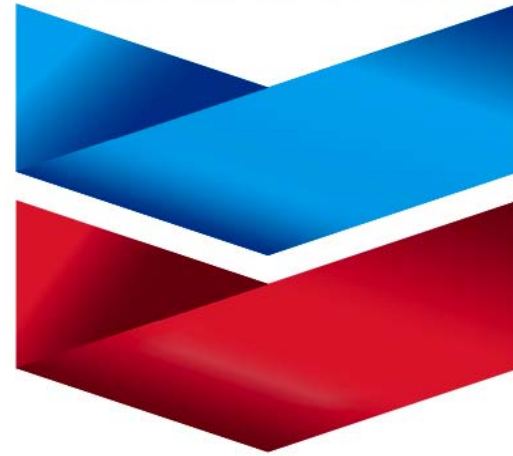

- Two examples of stop work that have been exercised by Khun Sunan and Somkid are:
 - Stopped a painter while he was standing on scaffolding (4 meter height) without fall protection.
 - Stopped crane operation while a rigger was working inside a basket as other workers were giving the crane operator hand signals to lift away.

After Stop Work Authority was utilized, they immediately reported to the Chevron representative and documented the use of Stop Work.
