**“Knowing what it is we need to do and doing it the right way every time.”**

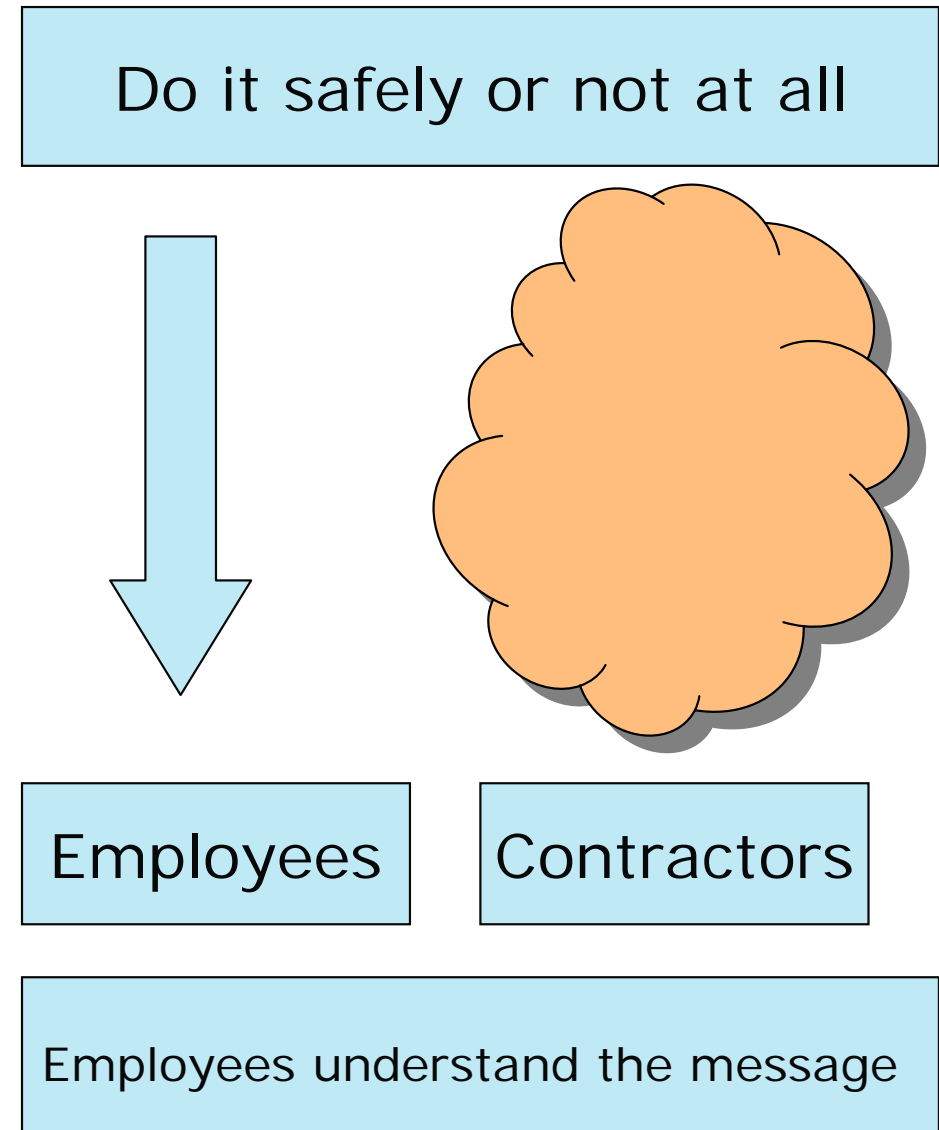
What are the expectations on contractor leadership,

## Operational Discipline



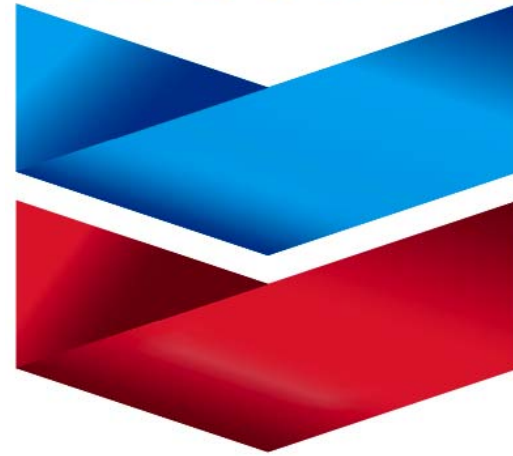
### What is ideal Contractor Management interaction
