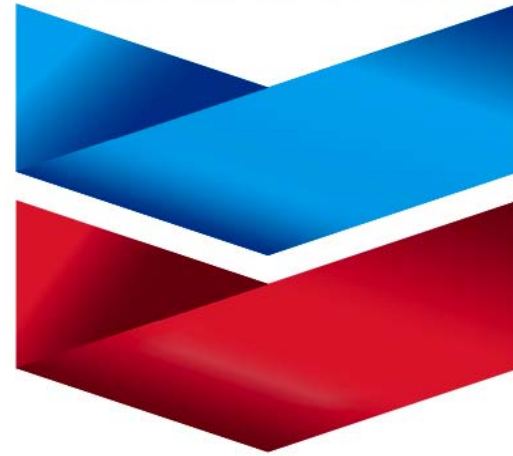
Vroon Offshore Services Pte. Ltd. "Dea Odyssey"
